# ADVENT FOOD DONATION FOR CLAGGETT MIDDLE SCHOOL

As we prepare our hearts and minds for this year's Advent season, the Mission Team has a "giving" mission to put before our congregation. We would like to focus on the most vulnerable in our community, the children. The children in elementary school receive weekender food bags. Until recently there were no supplemental foods available for children once they moved out of the elementary schools. There is a food pantry at Claggett and the students can take items from the pantry as they need them. Together with the counselor at Claggett, we have compiled a list of their needs. A copy of this list (in the form of a Reverse Advent Calendar) was included in a mailing that you received from the church as well as on our website and facebook page. You may also email the church office for a copy or stop in the welcome area and pick one up. Deadline for collection is Thursday, December 31<sup>st</sup>.

It is our hope to help stock their shelves by filling boxes with food items they can use. If you are only able to "give" a few items, that would be wonderful too. Boxes (or bags) can be dropped off in the church welcoming area and we will deliver them to the school when they resume classes after the first of the year.

# **MISSION TEAM DONATIONS UPDATE**

At their December 6<sup>th</sup> meeting, the Mission Team addressed the disbursement of their funds for 2020 year end. The following decisions were made:

- \$1,000 to an elderly woman who needs assistance with a sewer issue
- \$300 to a mother undergoing chemo with who needs help with Christmas for her four children
- \$1,200 for lunches for the staffs of Elmcroft, Medina Meadows and the Inn at Coalridge in recognition of their care for their residents
- \$500 each to Medina Light Ministries, Battered Women's Shelter, Children's Care Center, Operation Homes, Project Learn, Cups Café, Feeding Medina County and Birthcare of Medina in view of their ongoing need.

Thanks to everyone for their support of our mission projects. The response to filling the pantry of Claggett School has been wonderful. More on that later and also two new initiatives that we will be taking on and requesting your support for in the new year.

When making phone calls...find things to talk about. Questions to ask could be:

- 1. What books are you reading? Have you read a really good book that made you laugh? If they don't enjoy reading, ask about their hobbies.
- 2. What have you been watching on TV? Do you have a favorite TV series you've seen every episode of? Have you been watching classic movies, or binge-watching movies?
- 3. What kinds of food have you been eating? Have you tried any new foods recently?

- 5. What is your preferred music genre? What is your favorite music station? Do you have a favorite band or artist?
- 6. Are you an avid online shopper or do you prefer to visit stores in person?

# **Birthing a Promise**

Today is the fourth Sunday of Advent, the season of watchful waiting for the coming of the Christ Child. If you have practiced a ritual of lighting Advent candles, either in community or in your own home, then this Sunday you will light all four candles. As we do, we celebrate and acknowledge the gifts of this season - Hope, Peace, Joy, and Love.

On this fourth Sunday of Advent, we are also invited to receive the Christmas Fund Offering. As the promise of God's light and presence shines through the advent candles, we can bring hope, peace, joy, and love to those we honor with our special offering. Soon it will be time to put the advent wreath away for another year. But through your gift to the Christmas Fund Offering, you can keep hope, peace, joy, and love alive all year long for those who have served the church.

The Christmas Fund funds four programs: Christmas Thank You Checks, Pension Supplementation, Health Benefits, and Emergency Grants.

Christmas Thank You Checks are for retired United Church of Christ clergy and lay employees. Retirees with limited financial resources receive a gift at Christmas time as a way of saying "thank you" for years of service to the UCC. Last year, more than a quarter million dollars was given to 521 individuals, and the number of those helped increases every year.

Pension Supplementation is for lower-income retired United Church of Christ clergy and lay employees. These are monthly payments designed to bring household incomes up to a basic level to be able to afford basic needs like food, utilities, and medical expenses.

Health Benefits supplementation is for lower-income retired UCC clergy and lay employees who may receive assistance in paying Medicare premiums.

Emergency Grants are for currently active or retired clergy or lay employees who are facing unforeseen circumstances that create financial need.
