## WHAT IS IT?

We responsibly recycle broken or unwanted electronics to raise funds for our youth summer mission trip!



## WHY DO IT?

Humans generate about 50 million tons of e-waste, per year, full of toxic chemicals that affect every living thing when they end up in landfills!

## WHAT CAN I DONATE?

- Laptop and Desktop Computers
- DVD/VHS players
- Cords, Cables, Mice, and Keyboards
- Cellphones, Tablets, and Smart Watches
- Gaming Consoles and Games
- Stereos, Radios, Mp3 players, and iPods
- Old power tools and small metal appliances

## WHEN CAN I DONATE?

## WHAT ITEMS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED?

No batteries, thermostats (and items containing mercury), or refrigerators (and items containing refrigerant like air conditioners and dehumidifiers). Printers, fax machines, and other mostly plastic items won't be accepted either.

## WHAT HAPPENS TO THE THINGS I DONATE?

Items that are beyond their useful life will be salvaged for parts or shredded for metal. Following reduce-reuse-recycle, items that can be used again may be donated or resold to people who can use them, which will still keep it out of the landfill!

## WHAT ABOUT MY DATA?

We recommend wiping all your data off devices before you donate. We will be happy to help you remove computer hard drives to be destroyed or returned to you. Smart products must be unlocked and removed from your accounts (like "find my iPhone") so that they can be fully wiped and reset.

## WHAT ELSE CAN I RECYCLE?

We will accept CRT TVs/monitors, and LCD TVs/monitors with a \$20 donation. These screens contain lots of chemicals and most recycling centers charge to recycle them, so please help with the cost to recycle them responsibly!
